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Students learn through Project Based Learning (PBL), building on knowledge to develop deep understandings. PBL encourages students to explore topics meaningful to themselves, promoting in-depth research and collaboration, and connects inquiries to real-world scenarios. Reflection, feedback, and public presentation, along with utilising the expertise of local community members, are key components of PBL.



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
