Upon enrolment your child will be placed into a mainstream classroom and will be taught using the New Zealand Curriculum.

AN OVERVIEW OF OUR SCHOOL CURRICULUM

Learning Areas: English; The Arts; Health and Physical Education; Mathematics and Statistics; Science; Social Sciences; Technology.

Your child will receive a mid-year and end of year report based on their progress within the curriculum levels. In addition, ESOL students will also be issued an extra report at the end of the year based on their fluency and understanding of English.









Learning English

The Northcross Intermediate English Language Intensive Programme (ELIP) or ESOL programme is proud to offer support and learning opportunities for all students learning English as a second language.

At the start of the school year students new to Northcross start with an Orientation programme, designed to assist with adjusting to a new school, rules and expectations.

The Orientation programme is aimed at beginner learners and aims to ensure that these students will be better equipped to cope in the classroom after a three-week intensive course.

An introduction to PE (Physical Education) & Technology/Specialist classes are additional opportunities offered in the Orientation programme.

Our general ELIP/ESOL programme starts after all new students have been tested. Ongoing classes are run throughout the year, based on students' individual needs.

In addition to in-school ELIP/ESOL International Students can take advantage of our free After School language support held twice weekly.







Technology/ Specialist

Students are engaged in practical experiences across all disciplines with the emphasis on extending the children's creativity, curiosity and problem solving skills to generate a range of practical learning outcomes. Specialist classes include:

- Art (visual)
- Biotechnology
- Design, Make, Learn
- Drama
- Food Tech
- Graphic Design
- Music
- Photography
- Sports & Health Science

The Year 7 programme is designed to equip students with practical skills, knowledge and understandings across all 8 specialist subjects.

In Year 8 students self-select four areas to explore in more depth.

Home Stay

Northcross Intermediate School has hosted international students for many years.

We have an experienced team of International Staff including an experienced Accommodation Manager who is dedicated to the academic and pastoral care of our students.

International Students can live with either a homestay family, a Designated Caregiver (relative or close family friend) or their parent. We provide excellent support to our host families, caregivers and parents. Homestay families are chosen carefully and monitored by the school. Police Vetting is carried out on all Host families and Designated Caregivers. The majority of our host families have their own children attending the school.

A Pathway Visa allows a student to study up to 5 years on the same visa.
